

## COVID and Quarantines Guidelines:

1. Stay home if you are sick. (Students exhibiting symptoms will be sent home.)
2. Get vaccinated if you can.
3. Mask wearing is encouraged.

## Quarantines:

1. No quarantine is necessary if one of the following is met:
  1. You have been vaccinated,
  2. You have had Covid within 90 days,
  3. Exposed person was Mask on Mask with the positive person, OR
  4. Exposed person was wearing a KN95, or N95 Mask.
2. Quarantine timelines
  1. Any individual who tests positive will quarantine 10 days from the onset of symptoms or the positive test..
  2. Exposed individuals will quarantine for 10 days or 7 days with a negative test on the 7th day after the exposure ends.
  3. Individuals who are living with a person who has tested positive should follow the advice of the Weber County Health Department. Generally, positive cases in the household will require quarantines by household members.
